Re: *2008 Annual Giving Campaign (September 1, 2007 – August 31, 2008)*

The **2008 Annual Giving Campaign**, conducted from September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008, received private gifts totaling **\$264,684** from **540** donors.

Highlights of the 2008 campaign are:

- **Unrestricted Gifts totaled \$147,769**, roughly \$15,700 greater than last year. This amount has been directed to the Foundation's general operations and programs, as follows:

General Operations	\$ 116,599
Economic Development	\$ 363
Education	\$ 21,915
Health Care/Humanitarian Aid	\$ 3,755
Public Policy	\$ 5,137

- **Unrestricted Gifts of \$147,769** represent the 2nd largest amount in USUF history.

- **Total gifts for General Operations of \$116,599** - a growth of \$29,343 over last year's total and the 2nd largest amount in USUF history.

- **Total Gifts of \$264,684** - the 3rd largest annual sum ever received by the Foundation.
